WHAT IS WINDOW ETCHING AND HOW DOES IT WORK?

Window etching is a process by which a chemical solution is used to etch code numbers which cannot be removed into each window of a vehicle. The numbers are then entered into a national database with the customer's name, address and

phone number, as well as the vehicle's year, make, model and V.I.N. Although no security system will insure that your vehicle will not be stolen, some systems are more effective than others.

BENEFITS OF WINDOW ENGRAVING AND REGISTRATION

Professional thieves are reluctant to steal a vehicle that has been engraved with traceable code numbers because the chop shops do not want to buy vehicles that can be traced. The professional thief will not take the time or incur the expense of replacing all of the engraved windows.

When the professional thief realizes that the windows are engraved and part of a registration tracking system, the vehicle is usually abandoned. It is easier for them to go steal another vehicle that is not engraved and registered.
